Japanese Emperor Felicitates Dr. Ashwani Kumar

NEW DELHI, JULY 28: Former Union Minister for Law and Justice, Dr. Ashwani Kumar, has been conferred with the Grand Cordon of the Order of the Rising Sun, by His Majesty the Emperor Akihito, in recognition of his exemplary contributions towards strengthening bilateral relations and promoting friendship between Japan and India.

The Presentation Ceremony for the Investiture was held at the Imperial Palace in Tokyo on 9th May. Dr. Kumar attended the presentation ceremony and was given an audience with His Majesty the Emperor of Japan.

To celebrate the conferment of the Imperial Decoration, Ambassador of Japan to India, Mr. Kenji Hiramatsu organized a reception at his residence in New Delhi on July 28.
